Remembrance Service & Dedication of the Memorial Statue

St Luke's Chapel

Friday, 9th November at 8.45am



The College's Senior Chaplain, Canon Paul Thompson, is delighted to invite OEs and parents to a Remembrance Service & Dedication of the Memorial Statue in St Luke's Chapel on Friday, 9th November at 8.45am. They will be joined by M4 and Lower School pupils.

After the service the Dean of Guildford will offer an official dedication, and the statue will be unveiled by Peter Dodd (R 1943-47). Refreshments will then be served in Main Hall.

The statue commemorates the OEs and staff who gave their lives or fought in the Great War and all subsequent conflicts. Commissioned to be a timeless piece, it was created by Marcus Cornish, an established figurative sculptor.

The Education Trust led the whole project and raised over £8,000 to build the statue. We thank the OEs and parents who have contributed via the Annual Fund, with particular thanks going to Peter Dodd and the OE Lodge. Also involved in the project were the Art Department, Chaplaincy, Archive, CCF and the Estates Team.
